ng-if show ? <Thing/> : null

ng-class Use the classnames library:

ng-repeat {items.map(item =>
 <li key={item.id}>
 {item.name}

)}

ng-click
 Say Hello

ng-switch Use a normal JavaScript switch/case, and return
 components from the cases.

ng-style Pass an object to the style prop. Use camelCase for
 the CSS properties.

ng-change Pass a function to the **onChange** handler. Inside that
 function, call **this.setState**. Pass the value from state
 into the **value** prop.

Don't need: ng-href ng-cloak ng-controller
